

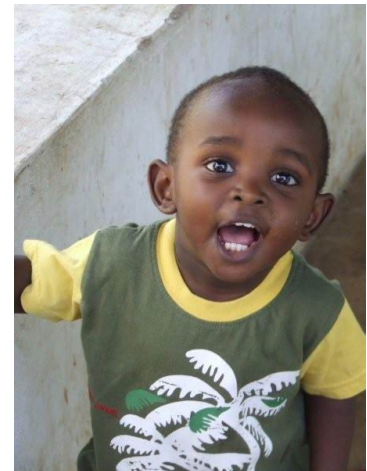

Following our last newsletter of July, we have the pleasure of informing you about what's been happening at DCV over the last few months!

In general all children are doing well, the small ones are discovering the world and the older ones are working hard in school. We have a new boy, Frederick who is 4 years. He was brought to the Home because he was abandoned by his family and then abused by relatives and finally saved by neighbours.



We are happy to inform you that we were able to repair both chicken projects, which had been damaged by the heavy rains. The house for the broilers has been re-inforced and currently about 80-100 birds are being sold every week.



The layers houses were also repaired and at the same time we extended the project by building a third house. We now have 300 layers of which the first 100 have started to lay eggs. The plan is to have a continuous production which will stabilize the finances for the Home in general.

The furniture workshop has been very busy and assisted the project in meeting some monthly cost.

Many thanks to all those who are assisting the Home by buying our products!

Our main goal for the remaining months of this year is to raise enough funds to enable us to buy another vehicle as the current minibus has become a danger on the road and costs the project far too much in repairs.
